


AFFIDAVIT OF DR. CYRIL H. WECHT

I, Dr. Cyril H. Wecht, state that I have reviewed the autopsy files and photographic evidence documenting the train accident on February 20, 2014, and the death of Sarah Elizabeth Jones, on the film set of "Midnight Rider", a feature film shot in Wayne County, Georgia.


1. My name is Dr. Cyril H. Wecht. I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, and under no legal disabilities. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this Affidavit and know them to be true and correct.
2. I have reviewed the autopsy files and the photographic post-mortem evidence regarding the death of Sarah Elizabeth Jones.
3. I am a forensic pathologist and medicolegal consultant. I have conducted more than 20,000 autopsies, and I have reviewed or been consulted in more than 40,000 additional autopsies since 1957.

Based upon my review and analysis of all the records and documents regarding the death of Sarah Elizabeth Jones, it is my opinion that that Sarah Elizabeth Jones was struck directly by a speeding locomotive. The locomotive in this case was Q12519.

4. It has been reported that a prop bed struck Ms. Jones and either pulled her or knocked her into the path of the train that killed her. I believe that is an incorrect analysis.
5. Ms. Jones had no markings or spinal injuries that would indicate that an intermediary object like the bed, or anything else, pulled her into the train, or struck her prior to the train impacting her body.
6. Based on my extensive knowledge in this highly specific field, I believe that Ms. Jones was killed by blunt force injuries of her skull by the speeding train, that she either tripped or fell into the side of the train, and that the prop bed was not a factor in her tragic death.
